Best Practice Approval Sheet

Hardwood Floor Installation/Refinishing

NOTE: All descriptions are based on visibility from 2' in "natural light"



Installation, Sand and Prep

- o Materials are delivered 48 hours before installation and neatly organized onsite
- O Site is completely partitioned, swept, and vacuumed (including floor, trim, vents, outlets, cabinets, etc.)
- o Substrate has been repaired, and leveled where necessary
- o NEW Select Grade materials are used
- New butt joints and seams are square and tight <1/16" (business card thickness)
- o At least three grades of sandpaper is used (except in rare circumstances)
- O Surface is free of drum marks, waves, and swirls
- o Edges and stairs are smooth with no sign of transition between tools (when sanding)

Staining and Finishing

- o Sanding sealer and at least two coats of urethane is used
- o Top coat should be free of ALL visible curtains, bumps and air pockets
- o Field Worker Policy is being followed
- o Base shoe is installed using coped joints and modified 45 degree ends
- o Transition strips are tight to all surfaces

Substantial Completion

- o All work has been completed
- o Client Walkthroughs has passed
- o All related change orders have been resolved
- Extra stain and sealer has been labeled clearly and stored in appropriate area onsite (Label indicating: Color Name/Rooms used/[ReTouch]/Date
- o All other product and materials have been removed from site

General Requirements

- o Work was completed on time
- o Daily check-in/out was conducted with Project Coordinator
- O Workspace was <u>rolled up</u> and swept clean daily
- o We have current certificate of insurance (with worker's comp and liability) on file

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
