Best Practice Approval Sheet Trim, Doors, Windows and Cabinets



Prep

o Materials are delivered and neatly organized at job site

Trim

- O Butt joints are made using 45 degree angle away from main line of sight
- o Inside corners are made using coped joint
- o All joints are tight enough to prevent paper from being pushed between the pieces
- o All joints are level (not visible >3')

Doors

- O Doors installed square, plumb, and level to <1/8" per 4'
- o Gap between door and jamb is consistent (from 1/8" to 3/16" throughout)
- o Door can be closed with one finger and will latch without being forced
- o Hinges and latch pocket are mortised cleanly

Windows

- o Windows installed square, plumb, and level to <1/8" per 4'
- New installations flashed according to code
- Remodels installed with sill tape, caulk onto jamb stops, and insulated at perimeter with Door/Window Great Stuff

Cabinets

- o Cabinets installed plumb both ways and level
- o Installed without spacing between boxes
- o Properly fastened to each other and to studs
- o Properly shimmed

Final Stage

- o All work has been completed
- o Client Walkthrough has passed
- o All related change orders have been resolved
- o Cut sheets and warranties from product have been given to Coordinator
- o Extra product and materials have been removed from site
- o Field Worker Policy is being maintained

General Requirements

- o Work was completed on time
- o Daily check-in/out was conducted through Project Coordinator
- o Workspace was <u>rolled up</u> and swept clean daily
- o We have current certificate of insurance (with worker's comp and liability) on file

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
